First repatriation of Myanmar refugees in Thailand begins

The first voluntary repatriation of 68 Myanmar refugees from camps along the Thai-Myanmar border began on Tuesday with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) calling the movement a "milestone" while underscoring it would not lead to an exodus. The return of the refugees is the first to receive endorsement from the Thai and Myanmar governments.

The return began on Tuesday with one family leaving a camp in the western province of Ratchaburi. Dozens more from Nupo Camp in Thailand's western Tak province followed on Wednesday (Source: Reuters, Bangkok.)

The Master Plan was adopted by ASEAN leaders earlier this year to ensure improved infrastructure, enhanced technology, lower supply chain costs, and ease of travel for all ASEAN people. The Symposium was organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Lao PDR as chair of the ASEAN Connectivity Coordinating Committee.
